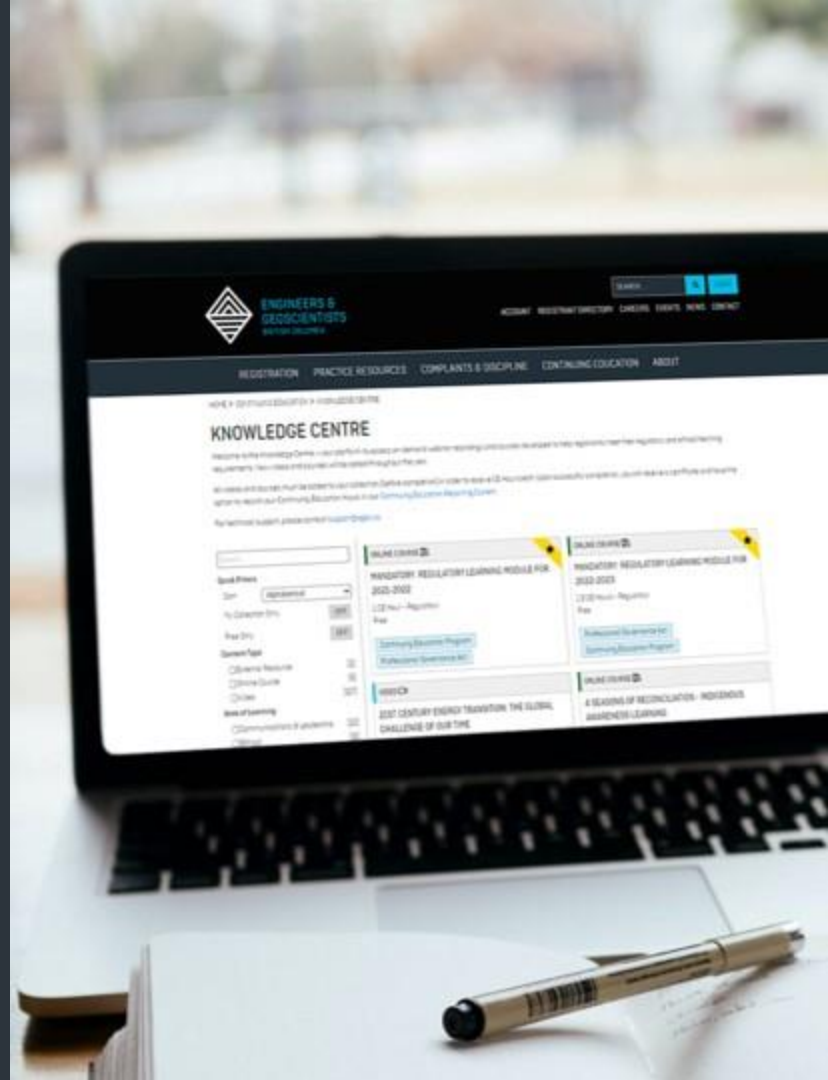


Continuing Education Program

Requirements due by June 30, 2025:

1. Complete the 2024/25 Regulatory Learning Module
2. Record 1 CE Hour of ethical learning
3. Create a CE Plan
4. Record at least 60 CE Hours of activities over the Three-Year Rolling Period.

Three-Year Rolling Period

Record at least 60 CE Hours of activities between July 1, 2022, and June 30, 2025.

- Struct.Eng. must record an additional 60 technical learning CE Hours directly related to their practice.
- Professionals first licensed on January 1, 2023, or later will **not** report 60 CE Hours this year.
- Check the Account Dashboard for your specific requirements.

Continuing Education Activities

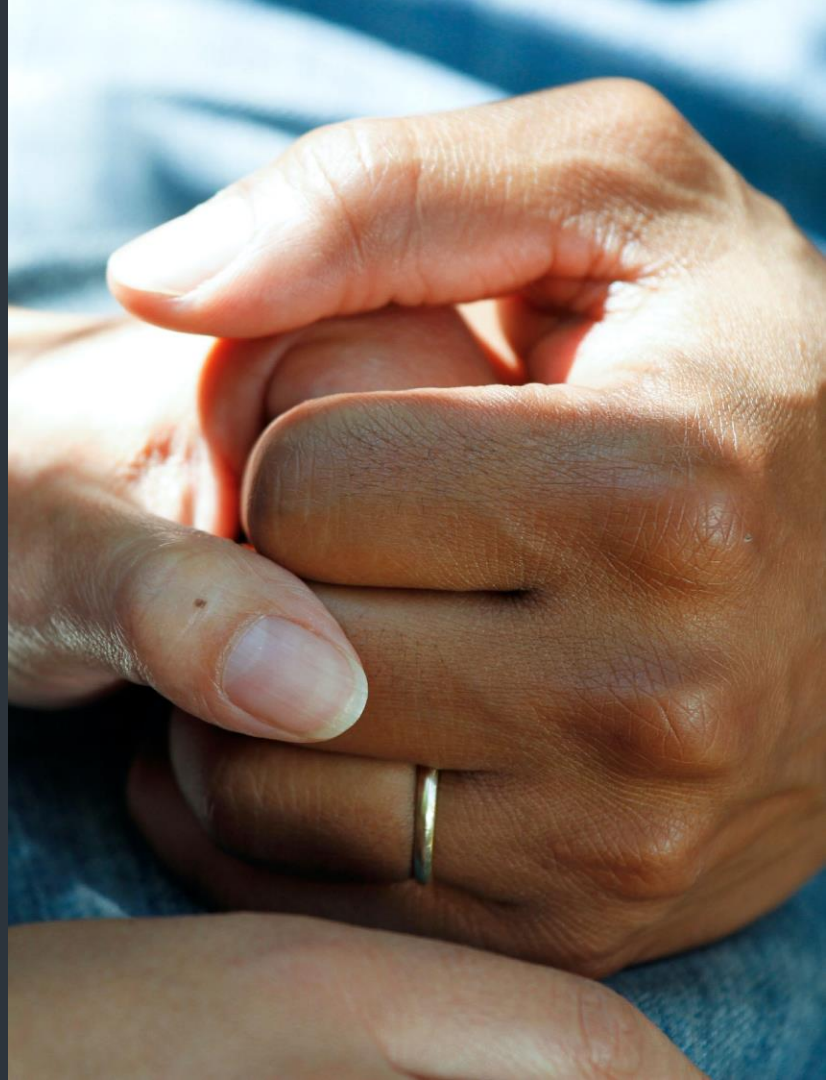
CE activities do not have to be offered through Engineers and Geoscientists BC to be eligible and can include:

- self-directed study,
- volunteering,
- presentations,
- seminars, conferences, courses, and other activities.

Exemptions

- Registrants on a professional leave of absence (e.g., parental, medical, or compassionate care) or experiencing similar extenuating circumstances may apply for a CE exemption.
- Application deadline: June 30

Annual Reporting

Submit between May 1 and June 30, 2025:

- Annual Reporting is the process to verify your contact and practice details, and complete annual declarations.
- Completed by all registrants (P.Eng., P.Geo., P.L.Eng., P.L.Geo., EITs, GITs, and Non-practising).
- Takes approximately 10 minutes.
